PANORAMA SYNOPSIS:

A pop-up kino-cabinet stands in the middle of a public space. Tickets are collected and the audience of 24 takes their seats inside.

The lights fade, the sound track starts, and a window draws open to reveal the world outside. The whole structure starts to slowly rotate 360° around its own axis...panning around the site, revealing the buildings, the movement, the space and the people which inhabit it.





As the rotations continue, reality starts to change and twist, becoming emphasised, abstracted & distorted. This progressive shift from reality into fantasy is created not just by the actors, but also by the people outside the structure, who are integrated and engaged to become the stars of the show.

The audiences become active co-creators of the performance...not just passive consumers of it.

Panorama re-awakens our aesthetic sense, re-mystifying the world around us and the interactions which take place in it.

Offering stand-alone shows, creative development workshops with artists leading to performances or specially commissioned projects, Panorama is a unique and innovative performing format that challenges current styles of interactive and site-specific theatre.

PANORAMA DURATION:



Panorama performances last up to 100 minutes as a series of fifteen minute linked "episodes" each telling a different story.

As the audiences inside the structure are changed after every 15 minute sequence, more people become integrated into the performances outside.

As an urban installation, Panorama can be presented over prolonged periods.

PANORAMA OPTIONS:

1. Panorama Performances:

With a core group of 4 - 6 artists, Panorama offers audience immersive, site-specific performances suitable for outdoor festivals and events.

From Shakespearian tales to dance flashmob style street parties, each episode creates unique interactive and transformative experiences.



With a core group of 2 - 5 artists, Panorama provides a unique opportunity to view, experience and reflect on ourselves and the environment we inhabit. Slowly rotating 360° the spaces and places around us become framed, highlighted, re-mystified and revitalised.

2. Panorama Urban Installation:

Particularly suitable for architectural, urban events and film festivals, Panorama reconnects people with space, place and each other.

With a core group of 3 - 5 facilitators, Panorama offers creative development projects for a maximum of 25 participants.

Open to individual students, artists groups and schools, the workshops lead to public performances.

Participants explore and focus their expressive visions and talents to create unique interactive, site-specific performances.

4. Specially Commissioned projects:

Working independently or in close collaboration with others, Panorama is able to write and create unique performances or installations tailored to the particular needs and wishes of the group or event.

Tom Greder is an itinerant artist focused on interactive contextual physical comedy. Born in Switzerland and raised in Australia, his style draws heavily on European theatre, circus and interactive street performing traditions.

Trained as a circus artist and contemporary clown at The Circus Space and Ecole Philippe Gaulier, London, since 1988 he has Independently produced & performerd nine full-length award winning productions, solo circus, theatre, cabaret and street theatre



performances as well as collaborated with national and international circus, theatre, dance and film companies. His work has brought him to over 400 theatre & street theatre festivals & events in 38 countries.

He has received numerous international performance awards including:
